## Summer Reading Program

### How it Works

This year's summer reading program is online!

Now you can log your summer reading from anywhere you have internet access.

1. Go to [www.sharonpubliclibrary.org](http://www.sharonpubliclibrary.org) and click on "Summer Reading Log."

2. Click on "Sign Me Up" to register. Create a user name and password that will be easy to remember.

3. Login with your username and password. You'll have your own homepage where you can log hours read, write book reviews and see how many prizes you've accumulated.

4. When you log hours read you'll have the opportunity to write a review of a book you've read. You don't have to write a review to be eligible for a prize. However, since the reviews will be seen by all registrants this is your chance to share with other readers the great (and awful!) books you've read this summer.

5. For every 3 hours read a notification will scroll across your homepage, telling you to visit the library for your prize - a paperback book of your choice. You'll also be entered in a drawing to have your picture on a READ poster that will be hung in the children's room. There will be five drawings and winners will be notified on August 23.
